Superlative

⇒ (1) Gold is more precious than any other metal.

(ii) Gold is more precious than all other metals.

Positive: $\Rightarrow$ No other metal is as precious as gold.
 -ve $\Rightarrow$ (SCN) $\Rightarrow$ so precious as gold.

Ashoka was one of the greatest emperors. (PCN)

Comparative $\Rightarrow$ than most other + PCN
